DECLARATION OF RESTRICTIONS FOR WATERCREST

ARTICLE 5 MAINTENANCE

5.4 **Stormwater Management System**. The following provisions shall apply to the Stormwater Management System:

C. SWFWMD Provisions. In the event the Association or any successor organization should fail to maintain the Stormwater Management System in accordance with SWFWMD regulations and permits, SWFWMD shall have the right, but not the obligation, to take enforcement measures, including a civil action for injunctive relief and penalties, against the Association or successor organization, if applicable, to compel it to correct such failure. If the Association ceases to exist, (1) the control of, or right of access to, that portion of the Stormwater Management System previously maintained by it shall be conveyed to any one of the appropriate governmental or public utility entities identified in the Environmental Resource Permit Applicant's Handbook, Volume I, and, if not accepted, shall be conveyed to a corporation not-for-profit similar to the Association; and (2) all the Owners shall be jointly and severally responsible for operation and maintenance of the Stormwater Management System in accordance with SWFWMD regulations and permits, unless and until a successor organization assumes responsibility for such operation and maintenance.
