## **Architectural Review Committee (ARC) Guidelines**

## Any change to the outside of your house requires an ARC

- Project request must be completed and submitted to <u>watercrest.arc.assistant.chair@gmail.com</u> during business hours Monday through Friday.
- The ARC will issue an approval, approval with stipulations, or a denial to the homeowner within 30 days of receipt of this request. If additional information is required from the homeowner or the contractor, the ARC will issue the homeowner a request for additional information. Please note that the review process will not commence until all information is received.
- Requests that are not approved by the committee will include reasons and recommendations, as appropriate and will be based on the Watercrest documents and parameters listed above and not on personal taste.
- An appeal of the decision may be submitted to the ARC in writing or email by the applicant and will be considered and responded to within 30 days by the ARC.
- Project must be compliant with the Declaration of Restrictions for Watercrest.
- Work requiring construction, including but not limited to, pool/cage installation, extended lanai or home additions, must be performed by Florida licensed and insured contractors.
- Damage to persons or property, and the repair thereof, associated with the requested project is the sole responsibility of the homeowner and/or contractor.
- Project may not have negative impact to or infringe upon community common areas and/or community drainage plans.
